Literature Bags



***An Extraordinary Egg* by Leo Lionni** (barcode 1656) – Use the alligator and frog puppets to bring this story, about 3 curious frogs and their extraordinary discovery, to life.



***Bunny Cakes* by Rosemary Wells** (barcode: 1990) – Act out the story with the bunny puppet, make Max’s lists and laugh at all his mishaps; all while you enjoy this fun story.



***The Doorbell Rang* by Pat Hutchins** (barcode: 3526) – Will there be enough cookies to go around? Count the cookies and read the story to see what happens.



***Frederick* by Leo Lionni** (barcode: 3674) – Frederick the mouse is a dreamer. Is he being lazy while the others work or is he really helping? You decide.



***Gregory the Terrible Eater* by Mitchell Sharmat** (barcode: 3609) – As you share this delightful story about Gregory and his eating habits; use the “food” items to make the story come to life.



***Growing Vegetable Soup* by Lois Ehlert** (barcode: 3500) – Read this delightful story about growing vegetable soup. Then use the play food to make your own “soup.”



***I Wish I Were a Butterfly* by James Howe** (barcode: 1722) – Cricket wants to be a butterfly. The large plush cricket helps you to bring this fun story alive.



***Is Your Mama a Llama?* By Deborah Guarino** (barcode: 1874) – Learn about llamas and get to know Ilyod, the plush llama, as you share this wonderful story about animal mothers.



***The Little Mouse, The Red Ripe Strawberry and the Big Hungry Bear* by Don and Audrey Wood** (barcode: 1862) – How can a little mouse save his strawberry from the big hungry bear? Read this fun book to find out the answer.



***The Old Woman Who Named Things* by Cynthia Rylant** (barcode: 1854) - Read this fun story about an old lady and how she makes friends with a dog. Then use the foam shapes and markers to make the characters and act out stories of your own.



***Owl Babies* by Martin Waddell** (barcode: 1557) - Use the furry owl finger puppets to help you to tell the story of three owl babies waiting for their mother’s return.



***Rosie's Walk* by Pat Hutchins** (barcode: 3575) – The children can act out the story with the plush chicken as you read this great story about a silly chicken and a fox.



***Snow* by Uri Shulevitz** (barcode: 3534) – The children will enjoy acting out the story as you read this great book about snow and believing.

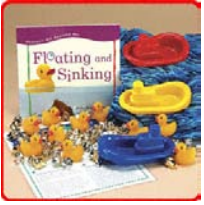


***Swimmy* by Leo Lionni (barcode: 3484)** – Can one small fish save himself and his new friends? Use the fish to act out the story and to find out the answer.

Science Bags



***Floating and Sinking* by Bryant Mole** (barcode: 1672) – Make science fun as you and your child learn about the concept of floating and sinking. This kit contains various objects that you can experiment with to see what will float and what will sink.



***From Tadpole to Frog* by Wendy Pfeffer** (barcode: 1730) – Make science fun as you and your child learn about the life cycle of the frog. This kit includes a stuffed tadpole and frog to help enhance the learning.

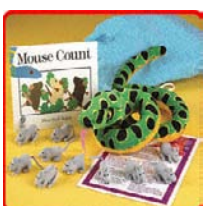
